### **NAC CONDUCTS TRAINING ON COUNTRY RESPONSE INFORMATION SYSTEMS**

The National AIDS Commission (NAC) will conduct a five- day training on the Country Response Information Systems (CRIS), scheduled to take place at the Khali Hotel from Monday August 10, 2009.

The aim of the training is to equip participants with skills to use the new version of CRIS which has been updated into version three. The Country Response Information Systems is a database that has been used by NAC and some of its partners in capturing, storing and analyzing HIV and AIDS related data for monitoring and evaluation of the national response to HIV and AIDS in the country.

The training will cover among other topics customization, set up, configuration, data inputs, as well as data analysis and reporting.

The training will be conducted in consultation with UNAIDS and all CRIS users in the country are set to benefit from this training from installation to effective use of the version three of CRIS software.

Participants will be drawn from NAC for the first two days, and the last three days will be for all partners to be drawn from government ministries, non-governmental organizations as well as and the private sector.

CRIS database has been operating in country from August 2006.
